Kauai Sea Farm is a company formed around the restoration of the Nōmilu Fishpond in Kalaheo, HI, with a focus on production of sustainable seafood. Extensively produced fish are harvested along with contained production of ogo and the only supply of Hawaii-grown clams in the state. Research projects are underway to investigate potential for producing sea cucumbers and native oysters in fishponds, facilitating a restorative approach to fishpond production utilizing native species. Join to discuss the challenges and opportunities facing these projects, as well as updates on the overall restoration of the Nōmilu fishpond system.
